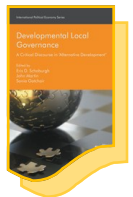

SALARY RULES (Section II – Clauses 1-22)

Basis of Calculation

The salary of a member of Staff is calculated on the basis of the date of the member of staff obtaining the minimum qualifications for the post and relevant experience. Normally, only experience obtained after the qualifications, is considered - one increment being awarded for each year of relevant experience - but the University will not be precluded from taking earlier experience into account. A staff member's publication record and special competencies that are assessable may be taken into account.
