SABBATICAL LEAVE

Section XI. 149. Eligibility and Priority

All members of staff (except Senior Library Assistants, Foreign Assistants, Foreign Language Instructors, Instructors and Research/Teaching Assistants) are eligible for Sabbatical Leave after six years of service with the University or after six years of service since a previous Sabbatical Leave or Fellowship Leave, subject to the rule that time spent on No-Pay leave shall not be counted as service to the University.

Pension Forum

The WIGUT (Jamaica) Pension Forum was held in the Multi-function Room of the Main Library on April 4, 2019.

To say the event was awesome in every respect is an understatement. Members who attended have described it as "a resounding success" and the external entities Stocks and Securities Limited, EduCom and Victoria Mutual Group who partnered with us have all expressed their thanks and enthusiasm for future partnerships because of the engagement from this Pension Forum.

The event was organized by the WIGUT (Jamaica) Pension Committee chaired by Mr. Noel Morgan with Co-Chair and Forum Co-ordinator, Miss Shana Hastings. It was designed to provide the answers to questions raised by the 289 respondents to the Pension Survey which was closed on April 1, 2019.

The Forum started at 10:00 am with a one-hour booth visit and purchase of WIGUT (Jamaica) memorabilia from the Registration Desk. Chair of the Pension Committee, Noel Morgan, brought greetings from the Committee after which Professor Paul Brown, President of WIGUT, brought greetings on behalf of the WIGUT Executive and Management Team. Mr. Dwight Walters, the UWI Pension Manager and his team shared specific and detailed information about the Pension Fund, its performance, options that members have, as well as how to access their pension information using the online platform, Hartlink. Their presentation was followed by that of Miss June Jackson, Assistant Manager, Pension and Staff Benefits, Mona Campus. Her presentation was extremely relevant and engaging as in addition to pension-related information, members learnt about benefits such as Study and Travel Grant and Book Grant, how to know their retirement date, what supplementation is and who is eligible for it. The members in attendance engaged with the presenters to ensure that they had a full understanding of the areas covered.

The refreshment hour also allowed members to visit the booths of the three entities that partnered with us. Each entity had a presenter who ensured that the members received useful information by drawing attention to their products that would be useful for retirement planning. The event culminated with a roundtable session where a full investment discussion was held incorporating questions from the audience as well as from the Moderator.

A sincere thank you to all who participated, and we look forward to an even more successful event in 2020.
