

WIGUT (Jamaica) AGM 2020

We finally were able to hold our Annual General Meeting on October 29, 2020. You will recall that the onset of COVID-19 led to a delay in meeting the April 30 deadline as required under our Constitution and the Executive voted to postpone the meeting to a later date. As conditions had not improved and governmentmandated protocols remained in place, the Executive Committee agreed that the AGM would be held virtually, as the Constitution did not prevent this.

Vice President, Dr Patrick Anglin, agreed to investigate and determine the most suitable platform to use to conduct the meeting and recommended the Zoom conferencing platform. He developed guidelines outlining the procedures for voting and these were distributed to members before the meeting.

As we have seen since the pandemic, meetings are better attended; this meeting was no exception. Over 200 members attended and, while far longer than the usual 2 hours, the meeting was a productive one. The General Secretary and the President reported as well as the Treasurer and members raised questions and received responses. The President and General Secretary's reports were distributed before the meeting.

Dr Minott Kates presided over the election of officers in which Professor Paul Brown was returned as President, Drs Anna Perkins and Patrick Anglin were returned as Vice Presidents and Miss Charmaine McKenzie was returned as General Secretary. The slate of Officers of the Union was completed by Dr Adwoa Onuora and Miss Anthia Muirhead, Assistant General Secretaries; Mrs Shana Hastings-Edwards, Treasurer (volunteered and ratifies by the Executive after the meeting), Miss Stascia Gordon, Assistant Treasurer (appointed during the meeting) and Mr Kurt Vaz, Grievance Officer. Dr Noel Morgan and Miss Hope Munroe did not stand for re-election as Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer. The President and General Secretary thanked Dr Morgan and Miss Munroe for their service to WIGUT over the years. The list of names of the entire Executive has been distributed by email and this newsletter includes photographs of some members of the new Executive.

The Management and Executive Committees seek your support as WIGUT (Jamaica) continues to work to protect the benefits and working conditions of its members during these difficult times.

USE OF BOOK GRANT FOR PURCHASE OF BOOKS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL MATERIAL

Members of the Academic Staff, Senior Administrative Staff and professional Staff are eligible for a Grant for the purchase of books and other professional materials. This Grant allows for 100% reimbursement for books, and other professional material purchased.

- The Grant may also be applied to subscriptions to learned professional societies or organizations which carry the right to receive proceedings and/or journals at no additional cost and/or at reduced levels. Where such right is not carried, subscription for mere membership of a society or organization may not be reimbursed.
- The Grant is accumulable.
- Staff members going on retirement may use the balance of the grant credited to their account at the date of retirement within one year.
- Staff members on contracts of less than three years duration who assume duties during the first semester will receive the full amount of the grant, however staff members who assume duties during the second semester will receive 50% of the amount of the grant. Staff members on contracts of three years and longer will receive the full amount of the grant, regardless of their date of assumption during the academic year.

Professor Ellis joined the staff of The University of the West Indies, Mona in 1982 as a Lecturer in the Department of Chemistry. He was promoted to Senior Lecturer in 1987, and then to the rank of Professor in 2011.

Professor Ellis provided leadership as Head of the Physical Chemistry Section for some 21 years. His distinguished record of original work in the area of liquid crystals, the thermal behaviour of soaps and in organic salts which are essential elements in the human diet, produced a number of publications in many

international peer reviewed journals. He was a dedicated educator who supervised MSc and PhD candidates and taught within the chemistry programme across all four

campuses of The UWI.

With an avid interest in sports. Professor Ellis served as the Deputy UWI representative the Jamaica Cricket on Board and was the first chairman of the Intercampus Games Committee at Mona. He actively participated in interdepartmental sporting activities and for many years captained the UWI Staff Cricket Team.


